Lake Henry dredging project-Mark Mickelson with SEH. The current DNR permit and plans are for hydraulic dredging. There are more permits needed for mechanical dredging, the lake would have to be drawn down, find a storage place for the dredging material, and how and where the hauling would occur. Stockpiling could be done on 3 sites: part of the old dredging pile site, the bass pond, and the area on Park Rd between the railroad and mobile home park. The dam is need of repair and if that repair was done in conjunction with the dredging that would help with getting a mechanical permit. The city has had no response from Source Energy in regards to signing the contract to put the lake spoils on their property. The County has stated that the roads will be monitored and shut down immediately if there are any signs of damage. The issue is driving these haul trucks down the new Broadway Street. The hauling can't be done during a thaw or when road weight restrictions are in place. Motion by A. Stevens to use the whey pond land for storage, the 3 de-watering sites discussed and using Broadway as the haul route, 2<sup>nd</sup> by J. Tranberg. Discussion: none. Vote: Ayes-6, Nays-0.
